Hypnosis Show & Empowerment Presentation

(Audiovisual/Technology/Production Requirements)

The audiovisual/technology/production requirements, as stated below, are considered a part of the Engagement Agreement. THE CLIENT shall supply WLE with the following production requirements for the engagement (see attached Stage/Floor Plan):

Staging:

- Stable stage area that is 24' x 12' and 3' to 4' high.
- Black backdrop.
- 2 sturdy stools (same height, no backs or arms, non-swivel).
- 20 sturdy armless chairs with backs.
- Set of sturdy stairs for audience participants to get on and off the stage.

Lighting:

- Front white and blue wash to fill the entire stage area.
- Lighting controller with the ability to control each light. The controller will need to be at the sound/tech table.

Audio:

- Professional P.A. system that must include adequate front-of-house speakers and stage monitors.
- 1 DI box that has two 1/4" input jacks and a ground lift switch. WLE will provide a laptop to be plugged into the soundboard.
- 1 high-end cordless handheld microphone (e.g. Shure Beta 58 or EV cordless handheld microphone). Please provide the batteries for the microphone.
- Adequate space at the sound/tech table area for technician to set up laptop and video camera—i.e. additional 6' table (see attached Stage/Floor Plan).

Electricity:

- 4 plug-ins at the sound/tech table for laptop, video camera, etc.

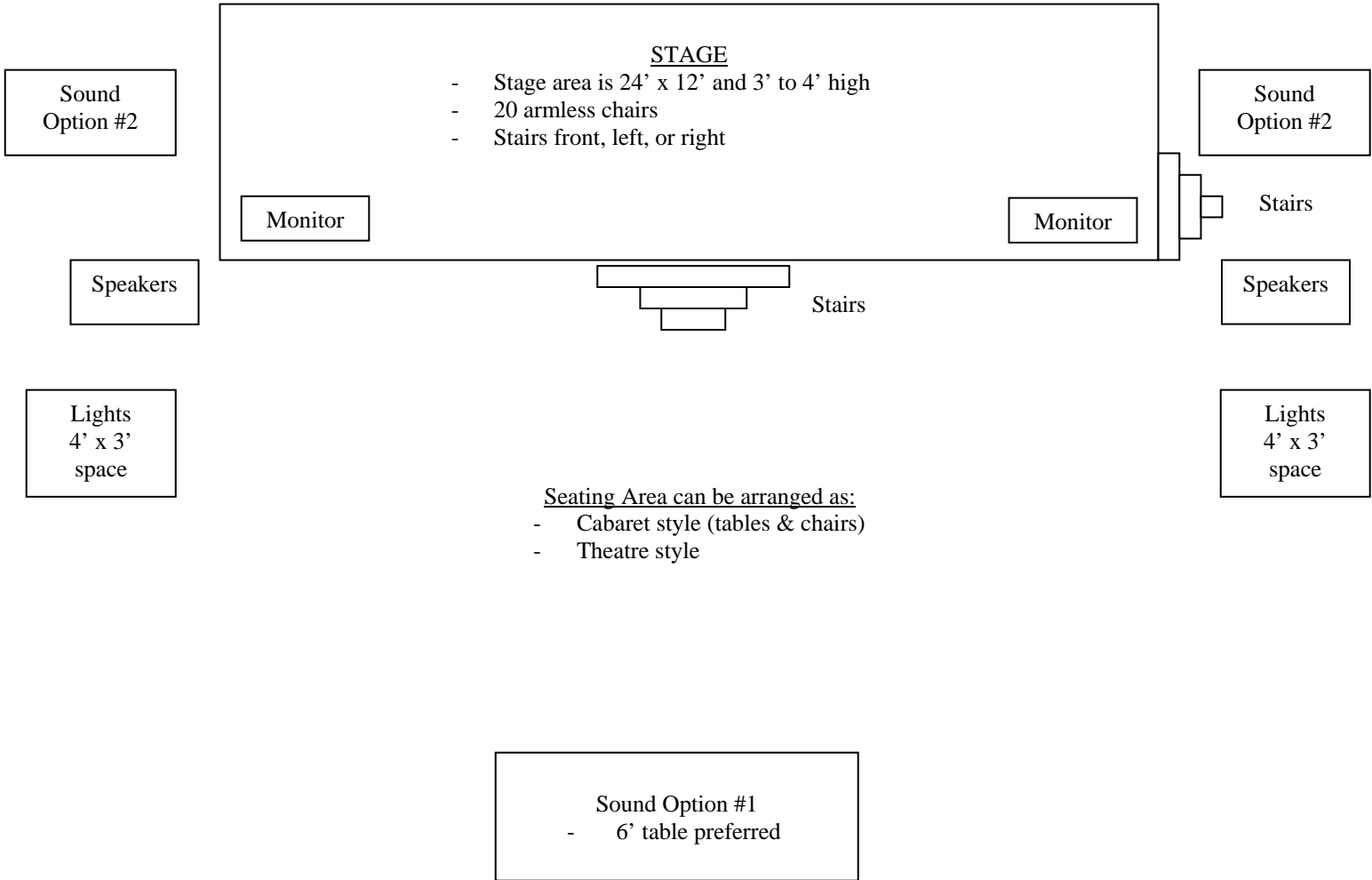
Miscellaneous Materials for Empowerment Presentation Only:

- Flip chart and blunt felt markers.
- Writing paper for audience participants.
- Pens/pencils for audience participants.

For audience sizes of 300+, it is recommended that THE CLIENT contact an audiovisual company to arrange for a projection screen to ensure optimum viewing for all audience members.

WLE will set up approximately 90 minutes before the engagement time, unless otherwise specified. During this time, a sound and lighting check will take place.
